1. Call for Papers

The 2nd conference aims at providing a platform for Policy Markers, Developing Partners, TEVET experts, Practitioners, Scholars, TEVET Graduates and Apprentices from all over the world to deliberate, network and present a wide range of perspective, scholarships and experts in pursuant of best practice in TEVET.

The conference is calling for high quality papers on the theme ***'Enhancing Skills Development for Economic Transformation Towards Malawi 2063'*** from both local and international presenters. The conference seeks to reposition the TEVET sector towards attainment of the Malawi 2063 Vision. The conference has the following sub themes as a guide on how the TEVET sector can positively contribute to the attainment of the Malawi 2063.

4. Format for Abstract and Paper Submission

a. Subtheme

b. Title: The title should not exceed 15 words and should be capitalized centered with font Century Gothic 14

c. Word Limit: Typically ranges from 200-400 words. Be concise and focused.

d. Keywords: Provide a list of relevant keywords for indexing, 3 -6 Words.

e. Font and Spacing: Specify font type (e.g., Century Gothic), font size (e.g., 12pt), and line spacing (e.g., single or 1.5).

f. File Format: Usually requires submission as a Word document (.doc or .docx) or plain text (.txt).

g. References: List of all cited sources in a consistent citation style of 7th Edition APA.

h. Author/Authors Details: Name/s, Position/s/Occupation/s, Address, Telephone Number/s and email address/es
