



INVITATION FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (EOI) TO DEVELOP ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING DESIGNS FOR NORTHERN REGION TEVET SERVICE CENTRE IN MZUZU

Background

The Technical, Entrepreneurial and Vocational Education and Training (TEVET) Authority is a regulatory body established in July 1999 by Act of Parliament. TEVET Authority was founded to operate as an independent and autonomous body responsible for coordinating and facilitating technical, entrepreneurial and vocational education and training in Malawi.

At its establishment, TEVET Authority was given the mandate to create an integrated TEVET system in Malawi that is demand-driven, competency based, modular, comprehensive, accessible, flexible and consolidated enough to service both the rural and urban Malawian population.

The major purpose of the Authority is to contribute to human resource development, through among other things, creating an adequate and competitive workforce for export-led socio-economic growth of Malawi.

Since TEVET Authority's establishment in 1999, programme delivery for the Authority has been based on strategic plans, the most recent being 2023 - 2030 Strategic Plan. TEVET Authority is using the strategic plan to guide the institution in the implementation of programmes in cognizance of reform processes taking place in TEVET sector as well as the national development agenda of Malawi Government with particular focus on Malawi 2063 and the ATM Strategy

As part of its continued growth and commitment to service delivery in the Northern Region, TEVETA intends to construct a modern office complex. The building will reflect the Authority's values of excellence, functionality, and sustainability.

Project Overview

Development of architectural and engineering designs for the Northern Region TEVET Service Centre in Mzuzu. The proposed project involves a two-storey, multi-functional office building to be constructed on a 40m x 70m plot located in Katoto, Mzuzu.

Scope of Services

Interested consultants will be expected to provide the following services:

- Preliminary design and architectural concepts
- Detailed architectural, structural, and engineering plans
- Interior and landscape design proposals
- Cost estimates and bills of quantities
- Submission of relevant statutory approvals
