Level 1: Malawi TEVET Foundation Certificate

The holder is an Assistant Operative who:

- Operates under close supervision of a competent personnel

Level 2: Malawi TEVET Intermediate Certificate:

The holder is an Operative who:

- Operates under minimal supervision of a competent personnel

Level 3: Malawi TEVET Advanced Certificate

The holder is an Artisan who:

- Works independently given proper instruction and guidance
- Makes decisions on familiar situations
- Provides solutions to known problems

Level 4: Malawi TEVET Diploma:

The holder is a Technician who:

- Works independently
- Makes decisions
- Provides solutions to unknown problems
- assign tasks to subordinates
- supervise subordinates

Steps to Attaining A Malawi TEVET Certificate

- Enrol in registered TEVET provider in a specified registered programme
- Attend both mandatory classroom instruction and attachment

- Complete both occupational and Fundamental components of curriculum
- Take all set continuous assessments and Achieve
- Be subjected to internal and external verifications and achieve
- Take all set National Summative Examination and get a pass
